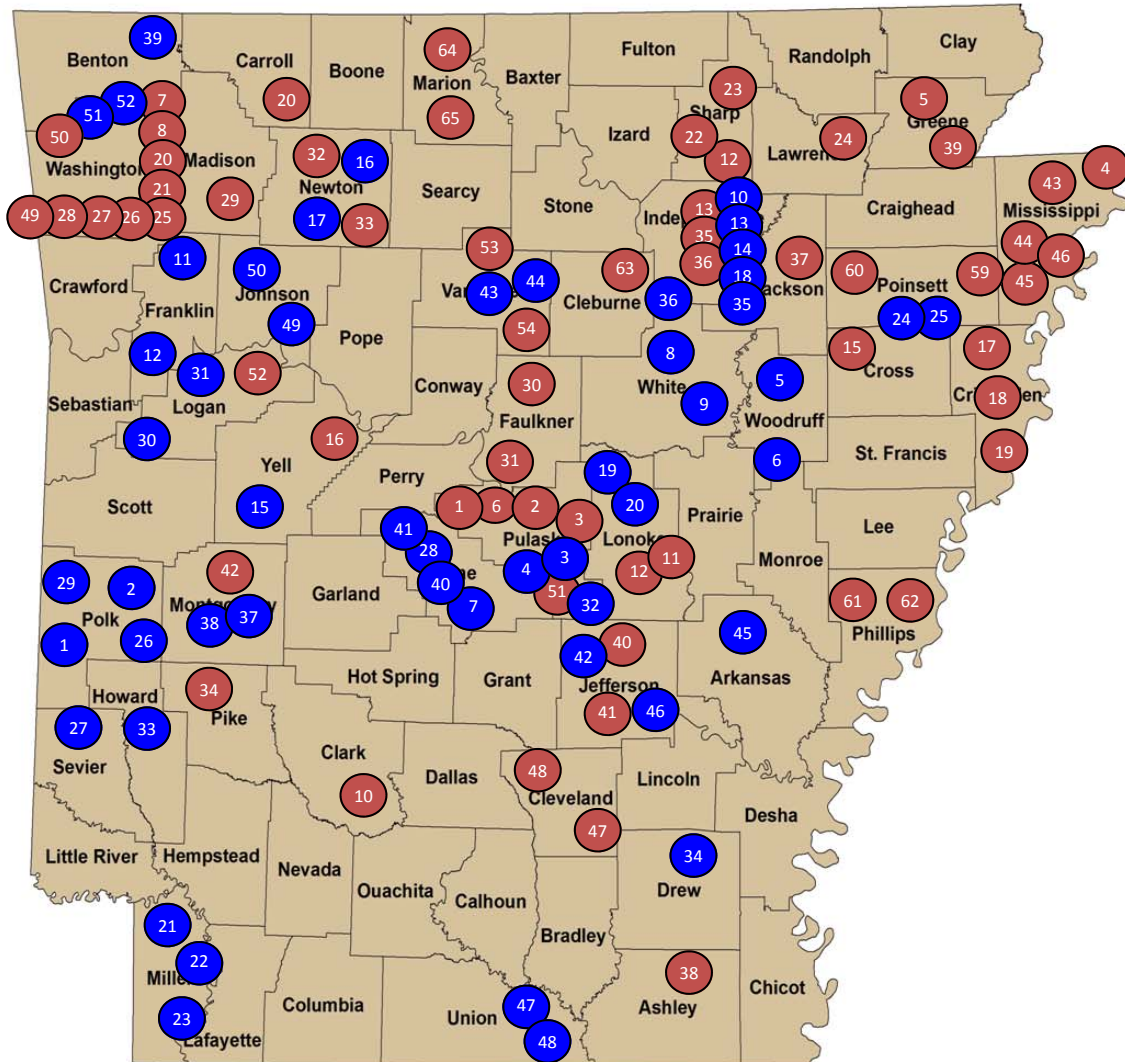




2010 & 2011 Grant Awards Map



The Child Wellness Intervention Project (CWIP) promotes health and wellness in Arkansas’s public schools. The CWIP grant is the first of its kind specifically designed to address the childhood obesity epidemic across our state. CWIP uses proven methods to increase time spent in physical activity through providing quality physical education programs. Students who are more physically active tend to be healthier and perform better academically. Overtime, CWIP schools can expect to see a reduction in overall BMI, a decrease in discipline and absenteeism, and an increase in learning efficiency. This grant provides physical activity curricula and equipment, teacher training, and other support to equip CWIP schools in their battle to combat childhood obesity.

For the **2010-2011** school year, the Commission awarded over **\$530,000** in grants to 52 individual schools in 26 districts around the state. Over 12,000 students participate in the CWIP program.

For the **2011-2012** school year, the Commission awarded over **\$650,000** in grants to 44 individual schools in 28 districts around the state. Over 8,5000 students will participate in the CWIP program.

Funding for this grant came from the Arkansas Tobacco Settlement Proceeds Act – an Act passed by 65% of Arkansas voters in 2000. This Act specified that tobacco settlement funds received by Arkansas should be used exclusively to improve the health of Arkansans through smoking prevention and cessation, increased access to health care and health education, and investment in important medical research.
